The students were responding very well. The overall cooperation from their side is good. There were 1 or 2 students who tried to make some nuisance but they were quickly removed from the session saving everyone's time.

I think the students lack exposure and guidance on interview preparation. The audience consisted primarily of 2nd and 3rd years. As per their responses, I have only understood that they have never looked at programming as a way to solve problems. It was a bit difficult to get everyone on the same page, but about 5-10 students were following everything I was saying.

Thank you for arranging this event as it will greatly benefit the college if the students take action on it. I hope more such practical sessions are organized with different speakers from different domains so that the students understand their way forward towards a successful career.
