Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to the proposal submitted by Methodist College of Engineering and Technology, King Koti Road, Abids, Hyderabad, Telangana-500 001 affiliated to Osmania University, Hyderabad under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

As per the decision of the Standing Committee constituted by University Grants Commission, in its meeting held on 01.09.2021, the Competent Authority has decided to grant autonomous status to **Methodist College of Engineering and Technology, King Koti Road, Abids, Hyderabad, Telangana-500 001** affiliated to **Osmania University, Hyderabad** for a period of Ten (10) years from the session 2021-2022 to 2030-2031 as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.4 (i) of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018.

The University is requested to issue necessary notification/order regarding the grant of autonomous status to the college as per UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 for Autonomous Colleges. The autonomous college is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, www.ugc.ac.in. Non compliance of the requirements and conditions in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -14 of the UGC Regulations – 2018. The college shall also apply in the prescribed format to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.
