- The existing scheme and syllabus of III & IV Semesters of CSE, UCE (Autonomous), OU is accepted with the following changes in the syllabi:
- (a) III Semester: Discrete Mathematics (Theory): The number of credits is reduced from 4 to 3. Further, the number of contact hours is reduced from 5 (3L+2T) to 4 contact hours (3L+1T). Furthermore, the order of books is changed and a few additional books are added.
